



Public participation in decision-making:

System of authorisation of field trials in Slovakia



Competent Authorities

Ministry of the Environment of the Slovak Republic (MoE) Department of Environmental Risk and Biosafety

- Act No. 151/2002 Coll. on the use of genetic technologies and genetically modified organisms, (Act on GMOs)
- implementing Decree No. 399/2005 Coll.
- contained use of GMOs
- introduction into the environment
 - deliberate release under part B of Directive 2001/18/EC
- placing on the market

Slovak Inspectorate of Environment (SIE)

control body for the use of genetic technologies and GMOs



Biosafety Committee and Panel of Experts

- advisory body of MoE
- follows new genetic technologies
- use of new knowledge for issuing of statement for MoE
- 14 permanent members of the Committee,
- 16 experts, review of the risk assessment of an application depending on their specialization
- Meeting of the Biosafety Committee
 - analysis of expert examination and public comments
 - issue of statement to the MoE



System of authorisation

- request for authorization / application for approval
- control of the application, call for amending
- disclosure at the website with the call for public comments
- the application is examined by an expert
- meeting of the Biosafety Committee
- information on application to the European Commission through a web portal JRC - SNIF form
- adoption of the decision
- disclosure of the decision on the website
- information to the European Commission on the decision through the web portal JRC



Public participation

- Application available to public on the website <u>www.minzp.sk</u> and <u>www.gmo.sk</u>
 with notice for public comments within 30 days
- Association of citizens may be party to the proceeding
 - written request to become a party to MoE within 10 days since the publication,
 - registered as association at least for one year to the date of submission of its request,
 - the objective to protect the environment or consumers pursuant to its Charter,
 - a petition signed by at least 100 natural persons as part of the request to become a party.



Party to the proceeding

- * Act No. 71/1967 Coll. on administrative proceeding
- Party to the proceedings is
 - the one whose rights, legally protected interests or obligations will be discussed or may be directly affected by the decision,
 - also the one who claims that the decision may directly affect in his/her rights, law protected interests or obligations until the contrary is proved.
 - the one to whom a special law recognizes this status.



A person other than a party

- * Act No. 71/1967 Coll. on administrative proceeding:
 - may participate on the proceeding or a part thereof under conditions provided by a special law
 - has less rights than a party
- * Act on GMOs:
 - Ministry may decide to grant **status of person concerned** to the association of citizens provided that
 - approval had been given before to the same GMOs,
 - enough experience with introduction in comparable ecosystems with comparable bio- and geo- conditions.



Evaluation of public comments

Many comments are questions on procedural approach of the Ministry of Environment – regulated by the Act!

- MoE deals only with public comments which
 - address issues of specific application,
 - contain technical arguments and quantitative data,
 - obtain data from renowned institutions.
- Act No. 71/1967 Coll. on administrative proceeding:
 - the principle of material truth
 - = to determine real state of things in each case



Decision / Authorisation

- decision on the introduction into the environment
 - must be issued within 90 days
 - includes statement of Biosafety Committee
 - requires to follow the procedures of work as they were stated in the application (implementation of control plans, waste management, taking samples for analysis, etc.)
 - requires to submit to MoE a report on monitoring results
 - guidance on appeal / review by the court
 - published on websites
- Information to European Commission web portal JRC
